6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the state board of parole."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 33.15.010 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 33.15.010. STATE BOARD OF PAROLE. There is in the depart-
10 ment a board of parole consisting of five members to be appointed by
11 the governor, subject to confirmation by a majority of the members
12 of the legislature in joint session. One of the members, who shall
13 be chairman of the board, shall be a person with training or experience
14 in the field of probation and parole, and he may be an official or
15 employee of the department but may not be an official or employee of
16 the division of corrections. One member shall have been a peace officer
17 in the state, one member a physician licensed to practice in the state,
18 one member shall have been a member of the judiciary, and one lay member
19 from the general public. Each member shall have demonstrated an interest
20 in the field of probation and parole. The term of each of the other
21 four members of the board is four years and until his successor is
22 appointed and qualifies. Successors are appointed in the same manner as
23 provided for the board members first appointed. A vacancy shall be
24 filled for the unexpired term. Members may be removed for cause only,
25 including but not limited to incompetence, neglect of duty, or misconduct
26 in office.

27 * Sec. 2. AS 33.15.020 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

28 Sec. 33.15.020. COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES. Members of the board
29 shall serve full time, with salaries as established by the governor,

1 and per diem and travel allowances as provided by law.

2 * Sec. 3. AS 33.15.100 is amended to read:

3 Sec. 33.15.100. ADOPTION OF REGULATIONS [RULES] AND HOLDING OF
4 MEETINGS. The board shall adopt regulations [RULES] which it considers
5 necessary or proper with respect to the eligibility of prisoners for
6 parole, the conduct of parole hearings, and conditions of release to
7 be imposed on parolees. [THE BOARD SHALL MEET AS OFTEN AS IT FINDS
8 NECESSARY, BUT IT SHALL MEET AT LEAST TWICE EACH YEAR.] Three members
9 constitute a quorum for the conduct of business.
