6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to driving while under the influence
7 of intoxicating liquor, narcotics, stimulants,
8 hallucinogenic or depressant drugs."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 28.15.220(a)(1) is amended to read:

11 (1) driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of
12 intoxicating liquor, narcotic, stimulant, hallucinogenic, or depressant
13 drugs [OR A NARCOTIC DRUG] to a degree which makes him incapable of
14 safely driving a motor vehicle;

15 * Sec. 2. AS 28.15.260(a) is amended to read:

16 (a) The court may not limit or suspend an operator's license or
17 privilege to drive a motor vehicle on the public highways for a longer
18 period than one year, except that, for the offenses listed under
19 sec. 220(a)(1) and (2) of this chapter, limitation or suspension shall
20 be as follows:

21 (1) one year [30 DAYS] for the first conviction;

22 (2) three years [ONE YEAR] for the second or subsequent
23 conviction [;

24 (3) THREE YEARS FOR A THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT CONVICTION].

25 * Sec. 3. AS 28.35.030 is amended to read:

26 Sec. 28.35.030. DRIVING WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING
27 LIQUOR OR DRUGS. A person who, while under the influence of intoxica-
28 ting liquor, narcotic, stimulant, hallucinogenic, or depressant drugs
29 [OR NARCOTIC DRUGS], operates or drives an automobile, motorcycle or

1 other motor vehicle in the state upon conviction is punishable by a
2 fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not more than
3 one year, or by both. In addition, his operator's license may be
4 limited or suspended in accordance with AS 28.15.260(a).
