6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to penalties for driving under the
7 influence of intoxicating liquor or narcotic drugs."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.35.030 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 28.35.030. DRIVING WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING
11 LIQUOR OR NARCOTIC DRUGS. A person who, while under the influence of
12 intoxicating liquor or narcotic drugs, operates or drives an automo-
13 bile, motorcycle or other motor vehicle in the state, upon conviction,
14 is punishable (1) for a first offense, by imprisonment for not less
15 than five days nor more than one year; (2) for a second offense, by
16 imprisonment for not less than 30 days nor more than one year; and (3)
17 for a subsequent offense, by imprisonment for not less than six months
18 nor more than one year. In addition, (1) for any offense a fine of not
19 more than \$1,000 may be imposed; and (2) his operator's license shall
20 be limited or suspended for the period of time specified in AS 28.15.-
21 260(a), except that for a third or subsequent offense the license shall
22 be permanently revoked.
