6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to teachers' retirement; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.25.100 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (d) Credit for service in the armed forces shall be granted for up
11 to four years if a teacher's entrance into the teaching profession was
12 delayed due to military service. This delay may be either before,
13 during, or immediately after finishing college. The teacher, in order
14 to obtain credit under this subsection, shall make contributions to the
15 system in the same manner as required for teachers on leave of absence
16 under AS 14.20.345(f) of this chapter. However, credit under this
17 section shall only be granted when the teacher applying has been granted
18 other than a dishonorable military discharge.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 14.25.110(a) is amended to read:

20 (a) A teacher is eligible for normal retirement if he has completed
21 either (1) at least 15 years of creditable service, the last five of
22 which have been membership service, and has attained the age of 60
23 years, or (2) at least eight years of membership service and has
24 attained the age of 60 years, or (3) at least 25 [30] years of credit-
25 able service, the last five of which have been membership service.

26 * Sec. 3. AS 14.25.220(23)(C) is amended to read:

27 (C) completing at least 25 [30] years of creditable
28 service, the last five of which are membership service;

29 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval

1 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
