6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the removal of bodies from
7 institutions."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 12.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 12.65.095. REMOVAL OF DEAD BODIES. (a) No body, in
11 coroners' cases, may be moved to a mortuary without the consent of
12 the next of kin and before the coroner expressly authorizes removal
13 of the body.

14 (b) A person, hospital, nursing home or other institution which
15 violates (a) of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon
16 conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by
17 imprisonment for not more than one year, or by both.
