For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the requirement of guides for
7 nonresident hunting."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.05.407(a) is amended to read:

(a) It is unlawful for a nonresident to hunt, pursue or take

11

brown bear, grizzly bear, polar bear, moose, mountain goat or sheep in

12

this state, unless personally accompanied by a person who is licensed

13

as a master guide, registered guide or assistant guide by the depart-

14

ment, or who is personally accompanied by a resident Alaskan over 19

15

years of age who is the spouse of or is related by blood within and

16

including the second degree of kindred. A person who applies for a

17

nonresident big game tag for the taking of an animal specified in this

18

section shall first furnish to the state, on a form provided by the

19

state, an affidavit showing that he will be accompanied in his hunt by

20

a person who is qualified under the terms of this section. A person

21

who falsifies the required affidavit is guilty of perjury.
