For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to nepotism; and providing for an

effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 39.10.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 39.10.010. NEPOTISM PROHIBITED. It is unlawful for a person

11

who is the spouse of or is related by blood within and including the

12

second degree of kindred to an elected or appointed official or the

13

official's spouse to be employed in the same branch of government as the

14

elected or appointed official, unless the person has obtained employment

15

through the results of competitive examination. Nothing in this section

16

prohibits a student at the University of Alaska from being employed by

17

the university.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval

19

or on the day it becomes law without approval.
