6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the regulation of dump-type  
7 equipment; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 42.10.020 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (5) motor vehicles operated by a person while transporting  
11 commodities in bulk in dump-type equipment except that permit and fee  
12 requirements provided for in secs. 130 - 240 of this chapter apply.

13 \* Sec. 2. AS 42.10.420(12) is amended to read:

14 (12) "construction contractor" means a contractor licensed  
15 by the state as a general contractor under AS 08.18 to engage in and  
16 who is actively and regularly engaged in the business of constructing,  
17 repairing or removing any kind of private or public facility or  
18 structure [AND DOES NOT INCLUDE "CONTRACT CARRIERS" AUTHORIZED TO  
19 TRANSPORT COMMODITIES IN BULK IN DUMP-TYPE EQUIPMENT UNLESS THE "CON-  
20 TRACT CARRIER" IS ALSO ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF CONSTRUCTING,  
21 REPAIRING OR REMOVING PRIVATE OR PUBLIC FACILITIES OR STRUCTURES AS  
22 A LICENSED GENERAL CONTRACTOR UNDER AS 08.18].

23 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
24 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
