6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the issuance of permits for the  
7 transporting of property for compensation."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 42.10.130(c) is amended to read:

10 (c) Except as provided in (a), (b), (d) and (e) of this section  
11 a permit shall be issued to any qualified applicant, authorizing the  
12 whole or a part of the operations covered by the application, if the  
13 proposed service is or will be required by the present or future public  
14 convenience and necessity; otherwise the application shall be denied.  
15 If the commission finds that (1) an existing transportation agency  
16 holding a permit is not supplying the necessary service at least once  
17 every seven days and (2) highway and weather conditions do not prohibit  
18 providing that service, it may issue an additional permit or permits.
