6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Board of Welding Examiners;  
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.99.030 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 08.99.030. SOURCE OF APPOINTMENTS. The governor shall  
11 appoint board members from a list of persons prepared by the Alaska  
12 Chapter of the American Welding Society and the Alaska Society of  
13 Professional Engineers [AND SUBMITTED AT LEAST 30 DAYS BEFORE THE  
14 EXPIRATION OF A TERM AND NOT MORE THAN 60 DAYS AFTER A VACANCY  
15 OCCURS IN AN UNEXPIRED TERM]. The list shall contain not less  
16 than two recommended candidates for each appointment. The governor  
17 may reappoint incumbent board members [SHALL MAKE APPOINTMENTS WITHIN  
18 30 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING THE LIST].

19 \* Sec. 2. This Act is retroactive to December 16, 1973.

20 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
21 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
