6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to credit for service in the armed  
7 service."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.25.100(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 (a) A teacher who served as an active member of the armed forces  
11 of the United States after December 31, 1939, having entered the armed  
12 forces immediately after service as a teacher in a public school, may  
13 receive creditable service under this retirement system if he continues  
14 service as a teacher in a public school within one year after his  
15 honorable discharge from the armed forces. This service may not be  
16 counted for purposes of determining the applicability of the 10-year  
17 limitation on outside service as provided for in sec. 220(3) of this  
18 chapter.
