A BILL

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For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to exemptions from the annual motor
7 vehicle license tax; and providing for an effective
8 date."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

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* Section 1. AS 28.10.210 is amended to read:

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Sec. 28.10.210. VEHICLES EXEMPTED FROM ANNUAL LICENSE TAX. Motor
12 vehicles owned by a municipality or a charitable organization [OTHER
13 LOCAL GOVERNMENT SUBDIVISION] are exempt from the annual license tax.
14 However, municipalities and charitable organizations [OTHER LOCAL
15 SUBDIVISIONS OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT] shall pay the cost of registration
16 plates, as determined by the department, at the time of applying for
17 registration. In this section

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(1) "municipality" means a general law municipal corporation

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and political subdivision, which is a first or second class borough
20 or city, or a third class borough, incorporated under the laws of the
21 state, including a home rule first class borough or city, or a unifi-
22 cation of these;

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(2) "charitable organization" means a nonprofit association,

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corporation, society or other entity organized for educational, cultural,
25 scientific, or other charitable purposes.

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* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
27 or on the day it becomes law without approval.

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
