IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

EIGHTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to first degree murder."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 11.15.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 11.15.010. FIRST DEGREE MURDER. A person who by means of poison, or by lying in wait, or in perpetrating or attempting to perpetrate arson, burglary, kidnapping, rape or robbery, or by any other kind of willful, deliberate and premeditated malice, kills another, or in the course of or for the purpose of resisting, avoiding or attempting to prevent a lawful arrest, or of effecting or assisting an escape or rescue from legal custody, kills a peace officer or other law enforcement officer acting in the course of his official duties or kills a person assisting the officer, is guilty of murder in the first degree, and shall be sentenced to imprisonment for not less than 20 years to life.
