6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to pay for state employees; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.27.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 39.27.010. BASIC SALARY SCHEDULE. The following monthly
11 basic salary schedule is approved as the pay plan for classified
12 and partially exempt employees of the state except those employees
13 who are members of the labor trades and crafts bargaining unit
14 formed under the authority of the Public Employment Relations
15 Act:

* Sec. 2. AS 39.27 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 39.27.015. COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENTS. (a) If the cost-of-living determined by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for Anchorage, Alaska increases 3.5 per cent or more between January 1, 1974 and July 1, 1974, the commissioner of administration shall adjust and increase the basic pay plan in AS 39.27.010 effective August 16, 1974 as follows:

Consumer Price Index Anchorage	Salary Schedule
Increase Per cent	Increase Per cent
at least 3.5 per cent but less than 4.5 per cent	1
at least 4.5 per cent but less than 5.5 per cent	2
at least 5.5 per cent but less than 6.5 per cent	3
at least 6.5 per cent but less than 7.5 per cent	4
at least 7.5 per cent but less than 8.5 per cent	5
at least 8.5 per cent but less than 9.5 per cent	6
at least 9.5 per cent but less than 10.5 per cent	7

(b) If the cost-of-living determined by the United States

1 Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for
2 Anchorage, Alaska increases more than 10.5 per cent between January 1,
3 1974 and July 1, 1974, the commissioner of administration shall adjust
4 and increase the basic pay plan in AS 39.27.010 effective August 16,
5 1974 at the same basic rate of progression provided in (a) of this
6 section.

7 (c) If the cost-of-living determined by the United States
8 Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for
9 Anchorage, Alaska increases 3.5 per cent or more between July 1, 1974
10 and December 31, 1974, the commissioner of administration shall adjust
11 and increase the basic pay plan in AS 39.27.010 effective February 16,
12 1975 as follows:

22 (d) If the cost-of-living determined by the United States
23 Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for
24 Anchorage, Alaska increases more than 10.5 per cent between July 1,
25 1974 and December 1, 1974, the commissioner of administration shall
26 adjust and increase the basic pay plan in AS 39.27.010 effective
27 February 16, 1975 at the same basic rate of progression provided in
28 (c) of this section.

29 * Sec. 3. AS 39.27.020 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

1 Sec. 39.27.020. PAY STEP DIFFERENTIALS BY ELECTION DISTRICT AND
 2 OUTSIDE THE STATE. (a) The following pay step differentials are
 3 approved as an amendment to the basic salary schedule provided in
 4 sec. 10 of this chapter:

28 (b) For purposes of (a) of this section "election district"
 29 means an election district designated in the governor's proclamation

1 of reapportionment and redistricting of December 7, 1961 and retained
2 as to the House of Representatives by the governor's proclamation of
3 September 3, 1965.

4 * Sec. 4. It is the intent of the legislature that the permanent
5 employees of the legislative branch receive pay increments comparable to
6 the pay received by the classified and partially exempt employees under
7 AS 39.27.010 - 29.27.020.

8 * Sec. 5. State employees who are members of the labor trades and
9 crafts bargaining unit formed under the authority of the Public Employment
10 Relations Act shall be paid according to the salary provisions of
11 AS 39.27.010 - 39.27.025 as those provisions read on the day before the
12 effective date of this Act.

13 * Sec. 6. This Act is retroactive to January 16, 1974.

14 * Sec. 7. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
15 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
