6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to pay for state employees; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 39.27.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 39.27.010. BASIC SALARY SCHEDULE. The following monthly  
11 basic salary schedule is approved as the pay plan for classified and  
12 partially exempt employees of the state except those employees who are  
13 members of the labor trades and crafts bargaining unit formed under the  
14 authority of the Public Employment Relations Act:

Sec. 39.27.015. COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENTS. (a) If the cost of living determined by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for Anchorage, Alaska increases 3.5 per cent or more between January 1, 1974 and July 1, 1974, the commissioner of administration shall adjust and increase the basic pay plan in sec. 10 of this chapter effective August 16, 1974 as follows:

Consumer Price Index Anchorage	Salary Schedule

at least 3.5 per cent but less than 4.5 per cent	1
at least 4.5 per cent but less than 5.5 per cent	2
at least 5.5 per cent but less than 6.5 per cent	3

at least 7.5 per cent but less than 8.5 per cent	5
at least 8.5 per cent but less than 9.5 per cent	6

1 (b) If the cost of living determined by the United States Depart-  
2 ment of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for  
3 Anchorage, Alaska increases more than 10.5 per cent between January 1,  
4 1974 and July 1, 1974, the commissioner of administration shall adjust  
5 and increase the basic pay plan in sec. 10 of this chapter effective  
6 August 16, 1974 at the same basic rate of progression provided in (a)  
7 of this section.

8 (c) If the cost of living determined by the United States Depart-  
9 ment of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for  
10 Anchorage, Alaska increases 3.5 per cent or more between July 1, 1974  
11 and December 31, 1974, the commissioner of administration shall adjust  
12 and increase the basic pay plan in sec. 10 of this chapter effective  
13 February 16, 1975 as follows:

24 ment of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for  
25 Anchorage, Alaska increases more than 10.5 per cent between July 1,  
26 1974 and December 1, 1974, the commissioner of administration shall  
27 adjust and increase the basic pay plan in sec. 10 of this chapter effective  
28 February 16, 1975 at the same basic rate of progression provided in  
29 (c) of this section.

1 \* Sec. 3. AS 39.27.020 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

2 Sec. 39.27.020. PAY STEP DIFFERENTIALS BY ELECTION DISTRICT AND  
3 OUTSIDE THE STATE. (a) The following pay step differentials are  
4 approved as an amendment to the basic salary schedule provided in  
5 sec. 10 of this chapter:

29 (b) For purposes of (a) of this section "election district" means

1 an election district designated in the governor's proclamation of  
2 reapportionment and redistricting of December 7, 1961 and retained  
3 as to the House of Representatives by the governor's proclamation of  
4 September 3, 1965.

5 \* Sec. 4. It is the intent of the legislature that the permanent  
6 employees of the legislative branch, the permanent and temporary employees  
7 of the judicial branch, and the professional employees of the University of  
8 Alaska receive pay increments comparable to the pay received by the clas-  
9 sified and partially exempt employees under secs. 10 - 20 of this chapter.

10 \* Sec. 5. State employees who are members of the labor trades and crafts  
11 bargaining unit formed under the authority of the Public Employment Relations  
12 Act shall be paid according to the salary provisions of secs. 10 - 25 of this  
13 chapter as those provisions read on the day before the effective date of  
14 this Act.

15 \* Sec. 6. This Act is retroactive to January 16, 1974.

16 \* Sec. 7. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
17 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
