6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to judgments against city or borough
7 school districts; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 09.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 09.30.045. JUDGMENTS AGAINST CITY OR BOROUGH SCHOOL
11 DISTRICTS. When judgment is against a city or borough school district,
12 but the school district in good faith had relied on a statute or
13 regulation that was, as a part of the judgment, declared invalid
14 by the court, and the district can demonstrate to the commissioner
15 of education that satisfaction of the judgment would have a severely
16 adverse fiscal effect on the district, the state shall, subject to
17 legislative appropriation and regulations prescribed by the commissioner,
18 reimburse the school district in an amount up to 90 per cent of the
19 amount of the judgment. This section may not be construed (1) to
20 create a debt of the state or (2) to vary the provisions of sec. 40
21 of this chapter setting out the procedure for the satisfaction of
22 judgments against boroughs, cities or other public corporations.

23 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
24 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
