6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the compensation of judicial
7 officers; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 22.05.140(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The chief justice and each associate justice shall receive
11 \$39,000 [\$36,000] annually as compensation. The compensation is
12 payable monthly in 12 equal installments. Compensation of the
13 chief justice or of an associate justice shall not be diminished
14 during his term of office, unless by general law applying to all
15 salaried officers of the state.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 22.10.190(a) is amended to read:

17 (a) Each superior court judge shall receive \$38,000 [\$33,000]
18 annually, as compensation, payable monthly in 12 equal installments.
19 The compensation of a judge shall not be diminished during his term
20 of office, unless by general law applying to all salaried officers
21 of the state.

22 * Sec. 3. AS 22.15.220(a) is amended to read:

23 (a) Each district judge shall receive \$30,500 [\$27,500]
24 annually as compensation, payable monthly in 12 equal installments.

25 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
26 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
