6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the compensation of judicial
7 officers; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 22.05.140(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The chief justice and each associate justice shall receive
11 \$42,500 [\$36,000] annually as compensation. The compensation is
12 payable monthly in 12 equal installments. Compensation of the chief
13 justice or of an associate justice shall not be diminished during his
14 term of office, unless by general law applying to all salaried officers
15 of the state.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 22.10.190(a) is amended to read:

17 (a) Each superior court judge shall receive \$40,000 [\$33,000]
18 annually, as compensation, payable monthly in 12 equal installments.
19 The compensation of a judge shall not be diminished during his term of
20 office, unless by general law applying to all salaried officers of the
21 state.

22 * Sec. 3. AS 22.15.220 is amended to read:

23 Sec. 22.15.220. COMPENSATION. (a) Each district judge shall
24 receive \$33,500 [\$27,500] annually as compensation, payable monthly in
25 12 equal installments.

26 (b) Each magistrate shall receive annual compensation to be
27 determined by the supreme court. Salary increases shall be determined
28 on the basis of percentage of pay increase the legislature provides
29 for state employees in the classified service. A magistrate's annual

1 compensation may be payable, at the option of the magistrate, either
2 monthly in 12 equal installments or semi-monthly in 24 equal install-
3 ments.

4 (c) No salary warrant may be issued to a district judge or mag-
5 istrate unless [UNTIL] he has filed with the state officer designated
6 to issue salary warrants, within 30 days preceding the date of his
7 monthly installment or within 15 days preceding the date of his semi-
8 monthly installment, as appropriate, an affidavit that no matter
9 referred to him for opinion or decision has been uncompleted or un-
10 decided by him for a period of more than six months.

11 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
12 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
