6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the performance of contracts let
7 by the state or a political subdivision of the state."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 36.10.090(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The commissioner of labor shall distribute to all departments
11 and agencies of the state government and to all political subdivisions
12 of the state a list of the names of persons or firms convicted of a
13 violation of this chapter. No person appearing on the list and no
14 firm, corporation, partnership or association in which the person has
15 an interest may work as a contractor or subcontractor, or as an archi-
16 tect, consultant engaged by an architect, or consulting engineer on a
17 public construction contract for the state or a political subdivision
18 until after three years from the date of publication of the list.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 36.10.100 is amended to read:

20 Sec. 36.10.100. PENALTY. (a) A contractor, architect, consul-
21 tant engaged by an architect, or consulting engineer who violates a
22 provision of this chapter shall have deducted from amounts due him
23 under the contract the prevailing wages which should have been paid to
24 a displaced resident, and these amounts shall be retained by the
25 contracting agency.

26 (b) A contractor, architect, consultant engaged by an architect,
27 or consulting engineer or the agent of a contractor, architect,
28 consultant engaged by an architect, or consulting engineer who violates
29 any provision of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon

conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500, or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or by both.

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
