BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 36.10.010 is amended to read:

10

Sec. 36.10.010. EMPLOYMENT PREFERENCE. In the performance of contracts let by the state or a political subdivision of the state for construction, repair, preliminary surveys, engineering studies, architectural design, consulting, maintenance work or any other retention of services necessary to complete any given project, 95 per cent residents shall be employed where they are available and qualified. If 10 or fewer persons are employed under the contract, then 90 per cent residents shall be employed where they are available and qualified. In all cases of public works projects, preference shall be given to residents.

\* Sec. 2. AS 36.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 36.10.111. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter "contractor" means a person contracting with the state or a political subdivision of the state, or employing or otherwise engaging the services of others, to provide a service included in sec. 10 of this chapter; the term includes but is not limited to a subcontractor.
