2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 11

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 EIGHTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Amending Rules 23 and 43(a) of the
6 Uniform Rules of the Alaska State
7 Legislature by changing the appointing
8 authority of the special committees
9 and the conference committees.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. Rule 23 of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature
12 is amended to read:

13 RULE 23. The presiding officer of each house appoints all special
14 committees and designates their chairmen unless a member objects
15 [OTHERWISE ORDERED BY THE HOUSE]. When a member objects, the Committee
16 on Committees makes the appointment.

17 * Sec. 2. Rule 43(a) of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature
18 is amended to read:

19 (a) If one house refuses to concur in the amendments of the other
20 it so notifies the amending house and requests that it recede from its
21 amendments. If the house refuses to recede, the presiding officer of
22 each house appoints three members to sit as a Committee on Conference
23 unless a member objects. When a member objects, the Committee on
24 Committees makes the appointment. The committee meets when mutually
25 agreeable to its members and when agreement on previously adopted amend-
26 ments to a bill adopted by either house is reached, the committee submits
27 an identical report to each house. If the report is adopted by both
28 houses the bill is enrolled, signed, and transmitted to the governor.
29 It is in order at any time to grant powers of free conference to the

1 Committee on Conference. If the members of the Committee on Conference
2 cannot agree on amendments or one or both houses refuses to adopt its
3 report it is then in order to appoint a Committee on Free Conference.
