8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Rule 44(a) of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legis-
10 lature is amended to read:

11 (a) When a bill has passed both houses the presiding officer
12 of the house of origin directs that it be enrolled. The clerk or
13 secretary transmits the engrossed bill to the enrolling secretary of
14 the legislature, who, with the staff of the legislative affairs agency,
15 has the bill checked for form and legal content before placement in
16 final form according to the legislative drafting manual. The enrolling
17 secretary is authorized to correct form, [AND] typographical errors
18 and clerical errors [AND IS REQUIRED TO CORRECT AND REPORT CORRECTION
19 OF ERRORS IN SUBSTANCE WHEN THE BILL IS RETURNED TO THE CLERK OR
20 SECRETARY OF THE HOUSE OF ORIGIN]. When a clerical [SUBSTANTIVE]
21 correction has been made [AND REPORTED], the clerk or secretary shall
22 advise the presiding officers of both houses before the bill is signed
23 and transmitted to the governor.
