5 Amending Rule 17 of the Uniform Rules
6 of the Alaska State Legislature.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. Rule 17 of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature
9 is amended to read:

10 RULE 17. No member may absent himself from sittings of the house
11 unless he has the leave of the house to be absent or is ill and unable
12 to attend. Any member consistently absent from meetings of a standing
13 committee to which he is assigned may be removed from that committee by
14 the Committee on Committees upon a showing that his absence is unwarranted.
15 Each standing committee shall maintain a written record of attendance at all committee meetings. The reason for a member's absence shall be recorded as a part of the record and committee attendance records shall be furnished to any person upon demand.
