5 Amending Rule 25(a) of the Uniform
6 Rules of the Alaska State Legislature.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. Rule 25(a) of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legis-
9 lature is amended to read:

10 (a) A committee acts, within sixty legislative days, on all bills
11 referred to it and reports its actions and recommendations to the house
12 as soon as practicable within that time period. A bill may be held in
13 committee beyond sixty days upon an affirmative vote of two-thirds of
14 the membership of the committee. If a committee has not acted on a bill
15 within the sixty-day time period and the time has not been extended by
16 a recorded roll call vote of two-thirds of the membership of the
17 committee, the bill shall be considered to be automatically passed out
18 of the committee without a "Do Pass" recommendation. The bill shall
19 then be processed as provided in (b) of this rule. Committee reports
20 must be in writing and the report must be signed by a majority of the
21 members of the committee. The report will note the recommendation of
22 each member signing the report.
