5 Relating to assistance of the Legis-
6 lature at the seventh annual Boys' State.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the seventh annual Boys' State program will be held on the
9 campus and facilities of the University of Alaska at Fairbanks, Alaska, in
10 June 1973; and

11 WHEREAS at Boys' State the delegates learn the duties of the various
12 offices connected with city, borough, and state government; and

13 WHEREAS part of the program connected with state government is the
14 election of a legislature, and the introduction and debate upon bills in
15 accordance with regular legislative procedure; and

16 WHEREAS the Legislature, as in past years, could be of valuable aid to
17 the operation of the Boys' State program, by having the Legislative Affairs
18 Agency prepare materials necessary for a better understanding of the legis-
19 lative process and by having designated legislators and Agency staff members
20 in attendance at Boys' State to aid in any way possible with the legislative
21 program;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature direct the Legislative Council to
23 authorize the Legislative Affairs Agency within the limits of its appro-
24 priations to assist in the preparation of legislative materials and, on the
25 request of the Boys' State chairmen, to have legislators designated by the
26 presiding officer of each house and two Agency staff members attend the
27 seventh annual Boys' State to aid the delegates in the legislative program.
