5 Honoring Alice H. Brown.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Alice H. Brown has recently met with an untimely death after a
8 long illness; and

9 WHEREAS Mrs. Brown was a lifelong Alaskan who, over the years, gave of
10 herself selflessly to many causes in order to better her community of
11 Anchorage and the state; and

12 WHEREAS during her long and able career she did and accomplished a
13 myriad of things including serving as a member of the board of directors of
14 the Alaska Federation of Natives; as chairman of the Alaska Native Political
15 Education Committee; as a member of the Rural Affairs Commission; as field
16 representative of the Kenaitze Indian Association; as a member of the board
17 of directors of both the Jesse Lee Home and Hope Cottage; among many other
18 activities; and

19 WHEREAS she, in addition to her numerous other activities and responsi-
20 bilities, spent countless hours working on passage of the Alaska Native
21 Claims Settlement Act;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature that it expresses its most profound
23 sense of loss at the passing of Alice H. Brown, but affirms and states its
24 view that her life and her devotion to her fellow Alaskans will long stand
25 as an example to those who may follow in her footsteps.
