6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Colonel James Carter, one of the 50 charter members of the
8 Civil Air Patrol in Alaska 24 years ago recently retired; and

9 WHEREAS Colonel Carter helped the organization struggle through its
10 infancy and for the past 14 years has served as commander of the Alaska Wing;
11 and

12 WHEREAS during his many years of service with the Alaska Wing, the
13 organization has been credited with saving hundreds of lives and of spending
14 thousands of hours in other rescue or search missions; and

15 WHEREAS Colonel Carter, in recognition of his services, has been awarded
16 the United States Air Force Exceptional Service Award, the highest award
17 that a civilian can receive; and

18 WHEREAS through his leadership the Alaska Wing greatly expanded its
19 numbers and abilities and gained numerous state and national honors;

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that it extends its most
21 heartfelt commendation for a job truly well done to Colonel James Carter and
22 wishes him every success in all of his future endeavors.
