7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the concept of limiting entry to the commercial fisheries of
9 Alaska is of major importance to the economic well-being of the state and to
10 the conservation of the state's invaluable fisheries resources; and

11 WHEREAS the Legislature is currently dealing with this vital issue; and

12 WHEREAS the constitutionality of any legislation providing for limited
13 entry presents a formidable obstacle; and

14 WHEREAS Professor Robert L. Fletcher, Professor at the University of
15 Washington School of Law, has, as a public service, donated his time and
16 effort in assisting the Alaska State Legislature;

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it expresses its
18 most sincere gratitude and appreciation to Professor Robert L. Fletcher and
19 the University of Washington.
