7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 Alaska champions, have played the East High School Thunderbirds of Anchorage,
10 Western Alaska champions, for the state basketball championship; and

11 WHEREAS the Juneau-Douglas Crimson Bears defeated the East High Thunder-
12 birds this week in the best of a three-game competition, thus capturing the
13 1973 state basketball crown; and

14 WHEREAS the 1973 Juneau-Douglas team has proven it can be classified as
15 one of Alaska's best teams ever; and

16 WHEREAS in the all-state competition the Bears clearly demonstrated
17 their ability as a great basketball team;
