5 Relating to "lay-off" procedures
6 involving state employees.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the present federal philosophy of a trim government is having
9 direct reducing effects upon federal funding to the state; and

10 WHEREAS cutbacks in federally funded projects necessarily will result in
11 some reduction in the state employee work force; and

12 WHEREAS there is every indication that purely state-funded programs will
13 be reduced to some degree in the near future, thus compounding the overall
14 effect on the state employee work force; and

15 WHEREAS recent reductions in the state employee work force indicate that
16 state "lay-off" procedures leave a great deal to be desired;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature respectfully requests the Governor
18 to direct the Department of Administration to revise its present regulations
19 on "lay-off" procedures so that more equitable results can be achieved in
20 the future; and be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Administration review the federal
22 procedures for "reduction in force" contained in the Federal Personnel Manual
23 and use these procedures as a guideline in drawing up state regulations.
