5 Relating to the insertion of valves
6 and special fittings in pipelines.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the easy injection and removal of the State of Alaska's royalty
9 gas and oil into and from pipelines for use in the public interest by
10 persons, local governments, and business enterprise and many others is
11 important for the maintenance of intrastate commerce and the general welfare;
12 and

13 WHEREAS the economic and timely injection or removal of gas and oil
14 via connections to main transmission lines would be greatly enhanced by the
15 installation of special fittings such as tees, wyes, spools, enlargers,
16 reducers, flanges, flange plates, valves and valve boxes within or attached
17 to the main during its construction at those places that the Alaska Pipeline
18 Commission directs;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature considers the inclusion of
20 these valves and special fittings within pipelines during their construction
21 is of vital importance to the social and economic well-being of the state;
22 and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to instruct
24 the commissioner of natural resources to prepare an estimate and list of the
25 number, type, size and location of the special fittings that may be required
26 by all parties enumerated in this resolution and any others showing justifi-
27 able interest; and be it

28 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to instruct
29 the commissioner of natural resources to transmit the list and estimate to

1 the Alaska Pipeline Commission for action by the commission as set out in
2 AS 42.06.340, and augment the list as the latest information and data permits
3 him to do so.

4 COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the commissioner of natural
5 resources, the Alaska Pipeline Commission, and all pipeline right-of-way
6 lease applicants.

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
