5 Requesting the establishment of a  
6 single transportation corridor from  
7 the North Slope.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the present Alyeska Pipeline route has been adequately defined  
10 and is generally accepted as the most feasible route for pipeline construc-  
11 tion; and

12 WHEREAS there is already a road under construction along the pipeline  
13 route which will be utilized in order to build the pipeline; and

14 WHEREAS in the future many other transportation systems will need to be  
15 built to the North Slope; and

16 WHEREAS there is extreme concern from various groups that in the future  
17 a proliferation of transportation systems to the North Slope will occur; and

18 WHEREAS the single transportation corridor approach encroaches least on  
19 land use in all arctic and subarctic areas;

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is  
21 respectfully requested to introduce meaningful priority legislation which  
22 would establish a single well-defined transportation corridor along the  
23 Alyeska Pipeline route.
