7 races.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS skiers from every point of the United States recently competed
10 in the "Federation International de Ski" competition in Anchorage; and

11 WHEREAS these races determined the team that will represent the United
12 States at the World Nordic Championships in Falun, Sweden; and

13 WHEREAS it was truly an honor for the State of Alaska and especially
14 for Anchorage to be able to host such a prestigious event; and

15 WHEREAS it was the consensus of participants, officials, and spectators
16 alike that this event was one of the best managed and run they had experienced
17 anywhere in the world;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it extends its
19 heartiest congratulations to all participants, officials and the myriad of
20 other persons who contributed their time and effort to make the event a
21 truly memorable one for all concerned; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislature congratulates those persons who
23 were successful in being named to represent the United States in Sweden and
24 wishes them every success.
