2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 20

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 EIGHTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the compensation of  
6 national guardsmen.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS for several years the cost of quarters and subsistence has been  
9 paid to the active members of the military in Alaska; and

10 WHEREAS the Alaska national guardsmen are members of the uniformed ser-  
11 vices when called to active duty for training; and

12 WHEREAS when a guardsman is called to active duty, for whatever purpose,  
13 he forfeits a civilian salary for military pay and allowances; and

14 WHEREAS his family expenses or his personal burden are not less than  
15 his counterparts on full-time active duty who are being paid housing and  
16 cost-of-living allowances under authority of federal law; and

17 WHEREAS test claims for these allowances have been submitted through the  
18 USARAL Finance and Accounting Office to the Finance Center, U. S. Army, and  
19 payment refused; and

20 WHEREAS a portion of the allowances has been allowed in subsequent joint  
21 travel regulations; and

22 WHEREAS it is asserted that the pay and allowances have always been  
23 authorized under paragraphs M4300 and M4301, volume I of the joint travel  
24 regulations under the definition of "members";

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is  
26 respectfully requested to direct the Attorney General to initiate a civil suit  
27 on behalf of all Alaska guardsmen for back-housing and cost-of-living allow-  
28 ances for the period from 1967 to date.
