5 Honoring Emery W. Chapple, Jr.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Emery Chapple has recently resigned from his state position as
8 Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety; and

9 WHEREAS his departure from the department culminates almost 15 years of
10 cumulative service as a peace officer in Alaska dating back to the commence-
11 ment of his tenure as a member of the Territorial Police Force in 1954; and

12 WHEREAS the responsibility of being the man ultimately responsible for
13 the safety and protection of thousands of Alaskans in an area the size of
14 Alaska is so demanding that it is almost incomprehensible; and

15 WHEREAS Emery Chapple has carried out his duties with the greatest
16 devotion and dedication to duty humanly possible with the continuing objec-
17 tive always being that of protecting the lives and property of Alaskans,
18 as well as attempting always to emphasize the better aspects of human ser-
19 vice;

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it extends, on
21 behalf of itself and all other Alaskans, its dismay at the loss of one of
22 the state's most loyal and devoted public servants who will be long
23 remembered as truly a "cops'" cop; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature conveys its very best wishes for
25 success to Emery Chapple in all of his future endeavors.
