5 Relating to the extension of the  
6 airstrip at Gunsight Mountain.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS there is an existing airstrip located at Gunsight Mountain  
9 but it currently can be classified as only an emergency strip; and

10 WHEREAS if the existing airstrip were extended it could be used for  
11 local aviation as well as in emergency situations for bush pilots, hunters,  
12 and the like; and

13 WHEREAS the extension of the strip would not only enable it to be  
14 utilized to the fullest extent of its potential but would vastly enhance  
15 the safety of all those who may have to utilize the strip in any given  
16 emergency; and

17 WHEREAS the need for a safe, usable airstrip in the Gunsight Mountain  
18 area by craft other than those encountering emergencies is great;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is  
20 respectfully requested to direct the Department of Public Works to extend  
21 the existing emergency airstrip at Gunsight Mountain and that this project  
22 be of the highest priority during the 1974 construction season.
