2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 30

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 EIGHTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to new construction by the
6 state.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS, because of the imminent commencement of construction of the
9 trans-Alaska pipeline, the state must build new schools in many areas of the
10 state; and

11 WHEREAS by the summer of 1975 it is projected that there will be a
12 shortage of available labor to work on such projects as the new schools that
13 are required by many communities; and

14 WHEREAS it would be to the state's advantage, both cost-wise and labor-
15 wise, to complete as much of the new school construction required during the
16 1974 construction season; and

17 WHEREAS, if construction of schools during the 1974 construction season
18 did not have to be delayed because of the lengthy period often required in
19 the state for contractors to receive and approve architectural designs of
20 new schools, immediate construction could, in most cases, be greatly facili-
21 tated, thereby benefiting the state, numerous children, and the employment
22 rate for the summer of 1974;

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it respectfully
24 requests the Governor to take all necessary action to ensure the construction
25 by the state of as many of the new school facilities that will be required
26 by the 1975-76 school year during the 1974 construction season; and be it

27 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct
28 the Departments of Education and Public Works, whenever possible, to use
29 existing architectural designs of existing schools so as to accelerate the

1 the commencement of construction of new schools by the state.
