5 Relating to assistance of the Legis-  
6 lature at the eighth annual Boys'  
7 State.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the eighth annual Boys' State program will be held on the campus  
10 and facilities of the University of Alaska at Fairbanks, Alaska,  
11 June 9 - 15, 1974; and

12 WHEREAS at Boys' State the delegates learn the duties of the various  
13 offices connected with city, borough, and state government; and

14 WHEREAS part of the program connected with state government is the  
15 election of a legislature, and the introduction and debate upon bills in  
16 accordance with regular legislative procedure; and

17 WHEREAS the Legislature, as in past years, could be of valuable aid to  
18 the operation of the Boys' State program, by having the Legislative Affairs  
19 Agency prepare materials necessary for a better understanding of the legis-  
20 lative process and by having designated legislators and Agency staff members  
21 in attendance at Boys' State to aid in any way possible with the legislative  
22 program;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature direct the Legislative  
24 Council to authorize the Legislative Affairs Agency within the limits of  
25 its appropriations to assist in the preparation of legislative materials and,  
26 on the request of the Boys' State chairmen, to have legislators designated  
27 by the presiding officer of each house and two Agency staff members attend  
28 the eighth annual Boys' State to aid the delegates in the legislative  
29 program.
