5 Relating to the inclusion of Low  
6 Point Road in the state highway  
7 system.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS in 1972 the state spent the sum of \$54,000 to bring Low Point  
10 Road up to standard; and

11 WHEREAS, since the expenditure of those funds, the road has not been  
12 maintained and will rapidly deteriorate if it does not receive proper  
13 maintenance; and

14 WHEREAS the road is a continuation of the Seward-Anchorage Highway and  
15 is approximately a mile in length; and

16 WHEREAS the Kings Head State Park will be just south of the road and  
17 a proposed boat harbor will also very likely be constructed in the same  
18 area; and

19 WHEREAS the road traverses the beautiful Resurrection Bay area and is  
20 extremely heavily traveled and the traffic flow can only increase, and at  
21 a rapid pace;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is  
23 respectfully requested to direct the Department of Highways to include Low  
24 Point Road within the state highway system at the earliest possible time  
25 so that the road will receive proper care and maintenance at all times.
