5 Relating to the safety of school children
6 at Gruening Park.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS over one hundred children of school age live in Gruening Park in
9 Juneau; and

10 WHEREAS every school day these children must wait on the road leading
11 into the park for their school buses; and

12 WHEREAS the children must stand on the road itself because it is not
13 wide enough to allow them to stand alongside the road; and

14 WHEREAS this circumstance presents a great hazard both to the children
15 and to the many motorists going to and from the park; and

16 WHEREAS the City and Borough of Juneau owns the property on the south
17 side of the road where the new Switzer Creek school will be located;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is
19 respectfully requested to direct the Department of Highways to coordinate
20 with the City and Borough of Juneau for the purpose of providing an area where
21 the children living in Gruening Park may wait for school buses in safety.
