6 Relating to certain proposed  
7 regulations regarding drivers'  
8 licenses.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the Department of Public Safety is proposing new regulations  
11 pertaining to drivers' licenses; and

12 WHEREAS the proposed regulations provide for Class A, B and C licenses;  
13 and

14 WHEREAS it appears that the proposed classification of licenses is  
15 arbitrary, capricious and unwarranted; and

16 WHEREAS the classifications being proposed would place undue restric-  
17 tions and an unneeded burden upon many citizens in Alaska;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is  
19 respectfully requested to direct the Department of Public Safety to  
20 immediately cancel all consideration of the proposed regulations as  
21 currently written and to take the proposed regulations back under advise-  
22 ment with the objective of modifying the arbitrary and restrictive  
23 classification of drivers' licenses.
