5 Supporting the application of Kenai  
6 Air Service, Inc. for an air scheduled  
7 carrier certificate.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the transportation upon which Alaska and Alaskans rely has  
10 never been overabundant; and

11 WHEREAS the petroleum industry, in order to achieve its potential in  
12 and for Alaska, demands more and better transportation services; and

13 WHEREAS Kenai Air Service, Inc. with 24 years of successful air taxi  
14 service to its credit is presently pursuing an air scheduled carrier certi-  
15 ficate through the Alaska Transportation Commission and is proposing to  
16 connect Kenai and Valdez, the two largest oil centers in Alaska, with  
17 Anchorage, the largest metropolitan area; and

18 WHEREAS, in addition to providing timely and economical transportation  
19 of personnel and materials between these three centers, Kenai Air Service,  
20 Inc. will be the first air scheduled carrier to base its operations on the  
21 Kenai Peninsula and will provide healthy and beneficial competition on  
22 routes in that area;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature supports the applica-  
24 tion of Kenai Air Service, Inc. for air scheduled carrier authority and  
25 respectfully urges the Alaska Transportation Commission to give it favorable  
26 consideration in order to provide this important service to Alaska.
