5 Commending Joseph R. Henri.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Joseph R. Henri, Commissioner of Administration, has announced  
8 his resignation to return to the private practice of law in Juneau; and

9 WHEREAS, during the course of his 40 months as commissioner during the  
10 third administration of William A. Egan as Governor of the State of Alaska,  
11 Joe Henri has been successful in effecting significant reforms in budget  
12 preparation and management, as well as serving as chief of the state's team  
13 negotiating with the Alaska Public Employees Association under the pioneering  
14 Public Employment Relations Act; and

15 WHEREAS under Joe Henri's leadership the state has made significant  
16 strides in state government efficiency and fiscal management by adopting a  
17 program budget that enables the legislature to see more accurately where tax  
18 dollars are spent and how effectively state programs are being managed;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that Joseph R. Henri is  
20 commended for his stewardship of the Department of Administration and his  
21 leadership in bringing about budgetary and fiscal management reform during  
22 his tenure as Commissioner of Administration and wishes him well in all of  
23 his future endeavors as he returns to private life after 40 months of dis-  
24 tinguished service to the State of Alaska.
