BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. Sec. 8, art. II, Constitution of the State of Alaska is  
11 amended to read:

SECTION 8. The legislature shall convene each year on the third

13

[FOURTH] Monday in January, but the month and day may be changed by

14

law. Regular sessions are limited to sixty days. The legislature may

15

extend the session for a period not to exceed thirty days by a

16

majority vote of the legislature in joint session.

17

\* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed

18

before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity

19

with sec. 1, art. XIII, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the

20

election laws of the state.
