2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 9

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 EIGHTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to implementation of the  
6 Indian Education Act.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS Title IV of P.L. 92-318, the Indian Education Act, amended the  
9 Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 with respect to Indian  
10 children and also amended the Adult Education Act to authorize special pro-  
11 jects for Indians; and

12 WHEREAS the United States Congress has appropriated funds for the  
13 implementation of P.L. 92-318 but the expenditure of these already appropri-  
14 ated funds has been held up by the Office of Management and Budget; and

15 WHEREAS appropriations already made are to be used for, among other  
16 things, Indian-controlled schools; special Indian programs to be used by  
17 tribes, organizations, local education agencies, colleges and universities;  
18 adult Indian education; the training and retraining of Bureau of Indian  
19 Affairs teachers; and for the development and staffing of the Office of  
20 Indian Education and the National Advisory Council on Indian Education; and

21 WHEREAS the full and immediate implementation of P.L. 92-318 is neces-  
22 sary for the health and well-being of the many thousands of U. S. citizens  
23 who will be benefited by the various programs set out in this legislation;

24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that the Office of Management  
25 and Budget is urgently requested to immediately release any and all funds  
26 appropriated for the implementation of P.L. 92-318.

27 COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Richard M.  
28 Nixon, President of the United States; the Honorable Roy L. Ash, Director  
29 Designate, Office of Management and Budget; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens

1 and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators, members of the Alaska delega-  
2 tion in Congress.
