5 Honoring John C. Flanigan.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

7 WHEREAS for 38 years John C. Flanigan has dedicated himself to the
8 betterment of society and service to his fellowmen through his chosen career
9 in law enforcement; and

10 WHEREAS Chief Flanigan came to Alaska in 1956 to serve as the Chief of
11 Police of the City of Anchorage, leaving behind him a productive and illus-
12 trious service in the Montana Highway Patrol and the Federal Bureau of
13 Investigation; and

14 WHEREAS, during his nearly 17 years as chief law enforcement officer in
15 Anchorage, that police department has grown and improved under John Flanigan's
16 expert tutelage to its present high position as an example for other law
17 enforcement agencies in the state; and

18 WHEREAS Chief Flanigan's unswerving devotion to his duties and to the
19 people of Anchorage and the state stands as a model of dedication unsurpassed
20 often at great personal sacrifice; and

21 WHEREAS Chief Flanigan's insight into and knowledge of Alaska's criminal
22 justice system and his leadership in this field will be sorely missed not
23 only by the people of Anchorage but of the state as a whole;

24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Senate that by the passage of this
25 Resolution the members express their collective lament at the retirement of
26 John C. Flanigan as Anchorage Chief of Police, but also wish to express
27 their commendations and thanks for a job well done.
