6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Guide Licensing and Control
7 Board; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.54.210(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor
11 and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000
12 or imprisonment for not more than one year, or by both, and may have
13 his license revoked for a period up to five years. However, a person
14 who engages in [OUTFITTING OR] guiding activity during the period
15 his license is suspended or revoked under [OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION
16 UNDER SEC. 200(e) OF] this chapter is guilty of a felony punishable,
17 upon conviction, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 or [AND] by imprison-
18 ment for not less than one year nor more than three years, or by both
19 fine and imprisonment. In addition to punishment for a felony [UNDER
20 SEC. 200(e) OF THIS CHAPTER], all guns, fishing tackle, boats, air-
21 craft, automobiles or other vehicles, camping gear and other equipment
22 and paraphernalia used in, or in aid of, guiding activity engaged
23 in during the period of suspension or revocation [A VIOLATION OF
24 SEC. 200(e) OF THIS CHAPTER] shall be confiscated by persons authorized
25 to enforce this chapter.

27 Sec. 08.54.220. INJUNCTION AGAINST UNLAWFUL ACTION. When in
28 the judgment of the board a person or corporation or other entity
29 has engaged in an act in violation of sec. 130 and secs. 200 - 210

1 [SECS. 100 - 200] of this chapter or the regulations promulgated
2 under them [SEC. 210 OF THIS CHAPTER], the board may apply to the
3 appropriate court for an order enjoining the act. Upon a showing by
4 the board that the person is engaging in the act, the court shall
5 grant injunctive relief or other appropriate order without bond.
