6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Guide Licensing and Control
7 Board; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.01.010 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (20) Guide Licensing and Control Board.

11 * Sec. 2. AS 08.54.210(b) is amended to read:

12 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor
13 and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or
14 imprisonment for not more than one year, or by both, and may have his
15 license revoked for a period up to five years. However, a person who
16 engages in [OUTFITTING OR] guiding activity during the period his license
17 is suspended or revoked under [OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER SEC. 200(e)
18 OF] this chapter is guilty of a felony punishable, upon conviction, by a
19 fine of not more than \$5,000 and by imprisonment for not less than one
20 year nor more than three years. In addition to punishment for a felony
21 [UNDER SEC. 200(e) OF THIS CHAPTER], all guns, fishing tackle, boats,
22 aircraft, automobiles or other vehicles, camping gear and other equipment
23 and paraphernalia used in, or in aid of, guiding activity engaged in
24 during the period of suspension or revocation [A VIOLATION OF SEC. 200(e)
25 OF THIS CHAPTER] shall be confiscated by persons authorized to enforce
26 this chapter.

28 Sec. 08.54.220. INJUNCTION AGAINST UNLAWFUL ACTION. When in the
29 judgment of the board a person or corporation or other entity has engaged

1 in an act in violation of sec. 130 and secs. 200 - 210 [SECS. 100 - 200]
2 of this chapter or the regulations promulgated under them [SEC. 210 OF
3 THIS CHAPTER], the board may apply to the appropriate court for an order
4 enjoining the act. Upon a showing by the board that the person is en-
5 gaging in the act, the court shall grant injunctive relief or other
6 appropriate order without bond.

7 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
8 070(c).
