6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Guide Licensing and Control
7 Board; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.01.010 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (20) Guide Licensing and Control Board.

11 * Sec. 2. AS 08.54.200(e) is amended to read:

12 (e) If the board revokes a license it shall notify the Department
13 of Revenue, and the person whose license has been revoked shall return
14 the license to the Department of Commerce [FISH AND GAME].

15 * Sec. 3. AS 08.54.210(a)(1) is amended to read:

16 (1) a master guide, registered guide, class-A assistant guide
17 or assistant guide to fail to timely report to the Department of Public
18 Safety, division of fish and wildlife protection [FISH AND GAME], and
19 in no event later than 30 days, violations by a client of a state fish,
20 game or guiding statute or regulation.

21 * Sec. 4. AS 08.54.210(b) is amended to read:

22 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor
23 and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or
24 imprisonment for not more than one year, or by both, and may have his
25 license revoked for a period up to five years. However, a person who
26 engages in [OUTFITTING OR] guiding activity during the period his license
27 is suspended or revoked under [OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER SEC. 200(e)
28 OF] this chapter is guilty of a felony punishable, upon conviction, by a
29 fine of not more than \$5,000 and by imprisonment for not less than one

1 year nor more than three years. In addition to punishment for a felony
2 [UNDER SEC. 200(e) OF THIS CHAPTER], all guns, fishing tackle, boats,
3 aircraft, automobiles or other vehicles, camping gear and other equipment
4 and paraphernalia used in, or in aid of, guiding activity engaged in
5 during the period of suspension or revocation [A VIOLATION OF SEC. 200(e)
6 OF THIS CHAPTER] shall be confiscated by persons authorized to enforce
7 this chapter.

8 * Sec. 5. AS 08.54.220 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 08.54.220. INJUNCTION AGAINST UNLAWFUL ACTION. When in the
10 judgment of the board a person or corporation or other entity has engaged
11 in an act in violation of sec. 130 and secs. 200 - 210 [SECS. 100 - 200]
12 of this chapter or the regulations promulgated under them [SEC. 210 OF
13 THIS CHAPTER], the board may apply to the appropriate court for an order
14 enjoining the act. Upon a showing by the board that the person is en-
15 gaging in the act, the court shall grant injunctive relief or other
16 appropriate order without bond.

17 * Sec. 6. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
18 070(c).
