6 For an Act entitled: "An Act adopting the Hold Harmless Act."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 45 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

9 CHAPTER 47. HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENTS.

10 Sec. 45.47.010. PURPOSES AND RULES OF CONSTRUCTION. (a) The
11 underlying purposes and policies of this chapter are to

12 (1) simplify and clarify the law concerning the enforceability
13 of hold harmless agreements;

14 (2) promote equitable contractual relationships between
15 persons;

16 (3) facilitate the administration and enforcement of the
17 negligence laws of the state;

18 (4) promote the public policy that all wronged persons should
19 have a remedy for injury suffered by a result of another person's
20 negligence;

21 (5) void agreements negating responsibility for a person's
22 own negligence.

23 (b) This chapter shall be liberally construed and applied to
24 promote its underlying purposes and policies.

25 Sec. 45.47.020. UNENFORCEABILITY OF HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENTS. A
26 provision, contained in an agreement, by which a party to the agreement
27 agrees to indemnify the indemnitee, or the agents or employees of the
28 indemnitee, against liability, claims, damages, losses or expenses,
29 including attorney fees, arising out of bodily injury to persons or

1 damage to property caused by, or resulting from, in whole or in part,
2 the negligence, act or omission of the indemnitee, or a legal entity for
3 whose negligence, acts, or omissions any of them may be liable, is
4 against public policy and is void and unenforceable.

5 Sec. 45.47.030. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter "agreement" includes
6 but is not limited to all contracts, leases, bailments, deeds, notes,
7 trusts, negotiable instruments, mortgage, options, real estate trans-
8 lations, security documents, financing statements, and insurance.

9 Sec. 45.47.040. SHORT TITLE. This chapter may be cited as the
10 Hold Harmless Act.
